


# Every Software Platform Requires Optimization

- Reconciling form and function is an everything kind of topic
- Every domain has platform constraints
- Every development conference has common session themes:
  - UX
  - UI
  - Mobile
  - Performance
  - Optimization

Gather Information



### Performance Changes in FileMaker 15

- iOS Application SDK
- Portal In-line Progress Bar
- Truncate Table
- Top Call Logging (on FileMaker Server)
- Cache Temp File Persistence (for both FileMaker Go AND FileMaker Pro)





### iOS Application SDK

#### Info

- "The iOS App SDK allows you to build a standalone iOS app from your FileMaker solution."
- "Users can access your FileMaker solution similar to other iOS apps without having to install FileMaker Go."

#### Pros:

- Streamlines installation and launch of custom apps
- Allows file structure (e.g., layouts) to reside locally on the device

#### Cons

No automated update mechanism





## Portal In-line Progress Bar

#### Info

- Displayed when portal content rendering will take more than a second
- Allows the user to interact with other aspects of the layout in the interim

#### Pros

- Nothing to develop it just works
- Smoother portal rendering
- Improved user experience

#### Cons

- Not a solution for slow portal problems
- Not something you can use 'deliberately'





### Truncate Table

#### Info

- Truncate Table [With dialog: On/Off; <Current Table>/Table: ""]
- "Deletes all records in the specified table regardless of the current found set"
- "Attempts to lock all records in the table before deleting them"
- "Does not delete related records even if the relationship is set up to do so"

#### Pros

- Great for cleaning up temporary tables, e.g. for virtual lists or data processing
- Can be used in a series to simulate a cascading effect

#### Cons

Caveats above





## Top Call Logging

#### Info

- Must be deliberately turned on to capture data
- Path: /FileMaker Server/Logs/TopCallStats.log
- Captures the top 25 client request that had the longest elapsed time to complete
- Adheres to the same(?) interval and log size as other client statistics
- See Advanced Techniques (below)

#### Pros

Detailed analysis

#### Cons

- Detailed analysis
- Mapping required to internal structure IDs





### Cache Temp File Persistence

#### Info

- Originally appeared in FileMaker Go 14
- Compares last cache file to current file state and discards changes
- Only downloads what it needs right away

#### Pros

- Nothing to develop it just works
- Maintains cached solution data for up to 15 days
- Some logical rules govern exceptions

#### Cons

None





Gather Information




### Oldies but Goodies

- Schema: Tables, joins and dependencies
- Records: Centricity, found sets, default for context
- Fields: Quantity, type and storage
- Triggers: See, touch and invoke
- Communications: Commits, round trips and notifications
- Window Dressing: Themes, complexity, scripting and interfaces in general
- Technical Infrastructure: Server HD, processor count, RAM and configuration

# Picking Favorites

- Use Themes
- Manage Your Found Set
- Plan for Narrow Tables
- Leverage the Server







### Use Themes

- Very little new to say:
  - Design: Performance, September 2014
  - Overview of themes in FileMaker Pro
  - Introduction to styles and themes in FileMaker Pro
  - FileMaker WebDirect db Services
  - FileMaker Themes Best Practices db Services
- In a nutshell:
  - more efficient storage = smaller download
  - faster to render
  - easier to develop
  - better user experience







### Manage Your Found Set

- Start empty handed
  - Open your solution to an empty table
- Consider the 'default' order of your script steps
  - Enter Find Mode then Go To Layout
- Orchestrate the user experience
  - Records that matter to that user, task or process
  - Recent history
  - Find/Filter vs. Browse/Sort








### Plan for Narrow Tables

- Learn the fundamentals of monogamous relationships ;-)
  - Data Modeling: Using One-to-One Relationships, DevCon 2015
- Divide tables along 'natural' lines
  - List view vs Form view
  - Small vs Large
  - Field sets







### Leverage the Server

- Learn the fundamentals of:
  - FileMaker Server Schedules
  - Perform Script on Server (PSoS) script step
  - Server-compatible script steps
  - Caching and indexing
  - Transferring a found set from the client to the server
- Mix and match







Rinse and Repeat



# Manage What You Measure

- WireShark
- Top Call Logging







### WireShark

#### Info


- Packet filter
- Can be used to isolate and capture IP traffic by port number

#### Pros

Great for isolated testing

#### Cons

- A bit complex to learn at first
- Requires analysis of dumped data
- No discrete info on what was moving or why







### Top Call Logging

#### Info

- Smart logging of detailed client statistics
- Under the Hood: Server Performance, Jon Thatcher

#### Pros

Great for catching the slowest stuff, even if not reported by a user

#### Cons

- A bit complex to learn at first
- Requires analysis of dumped data
- No control over what are the top calls in an interval
